

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS: UPDATED PERMITS, LAKE PLAN, AND IMPLEMENTATION GRANTS

Pigeon Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District invites Lake Management Teams to work over the next year (beginning January 1, 2021) with the Pigeon Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District Board to update the 2016 Lake Management Plan, including permitting for ongoing weed-cutting, and other action steps included in the 2016 Plan, and as revised in light of the 2017-18 draw-down of the lake.

The District desires to establish an ongoing relationship with a Lake Management Team to put together comprehensive long-term planning, to prioritize and to implement action items from the 2016 Plan, and including securing grants to partner with the City of Clintonville, Waupaca County, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, and other interested agencies, individuals, and communities to strengthen the water quality and recreational value of Pigeon Lake for all citizens.

Written proposals (no more than three pages) should be submitted by email to Dr. Jon Pahl, District Secretary, by December 9, 2020: <u>jonpahlwi@gmail.com</u> Proposals should include itemized budget of services to be provided, not in excess of \$20,000. The method for this procurement is competitive proposal, pursuant to Chapter 16 of the Waupaca County Code of Ordinances. After submission of the written proposal, qualified proposers may be requested to make a presentation to the District Board. The process allows for confidential clarifications, negotiations, and revisions.

This agreement will be governed and construed according to the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

Upon award, proposals will be considered public record and details will be posted online.
